"MIPDANIO" is a mnemonic to help you to remember the correct sequence to deliver a Verbal Mayday Distress Call via VHF Radio:

Letter	Meaning	Correct Use
M	Mayday (Distress Pro-Word)	"Mayday, Mayday, Mayday"
	Identity (Who You Are)	"This Is: (Vessel, Callsign, MMSI)"
P	Position (Where You Are)	"My Position Is: (Position)"
D	Distress (Nature of Distress)	"I am: (Sinking, On-Fire etc)"
A	Assistance Required (Immediate)	"I require immediate assistance"
N	Number of Persons-On-Board	"There are (X) persons on-board"
	Information (Anything Important)	"We are a 10-metre blue yacht"
0	Over (Requesting a Reply)	"Over"
